6:00 PM Town Clerk/Town Treasurer Report - Robin Miller did not attend as she had a scheduling conflict. Tuesdays are generally not a good day for her to attend. The issue of when to have our Selectboard meetings will be addressed at our next meeting.

6:05 School Budget - Patrick Healy presented the upcoming fiscal year school budget. The school budget will be going up \$750,000. This is driven primarily by increases in the following areas: a new teacher contract, administration costs, health care costs, capital improvements, and various other items. Other factors which increase the tax rate are that Twinfield has lost 100 students over the last 12 years; The common level of appraisal (CLA) in Plainfield is very low which has an upward effect on the tax rate. He estimates the rate will go up \$1.66 to \$1.91. An informational meeting will be held on February 28 at 6 pm at Twinfield Union School and on Zoom. A copy of the proposed budget is on the Twinfield School Board website.
