To meet the standards of our department that have been implemented for the protection of our community, this is our check list that must be completed before becoming a member of our team:

_____ National Background Check (**complete the forms below**). You will then need to contact Greg Light for his sign off on the application. **Phone: (802) 839-8878.**

_____ Your papers have been completed, and Greg Light has signed off on the application, you will then need to make an appointment with any facility that offers fingerprinting for the Vermont Crime Information Center.

_____ After your results from the background check are complete, for those that have had EMS or Fire training, we are required to have a **copy of your certificate from the Vermont Department of Health**. If you've had no training, please contact Greg Light for more information about classes. The classes are offered through the Vermont Department of Health and Vermont Fire Academy and we are subject to their schedule.

Upon approval from the Plainfield Fire and Rescue Department of your application, fees for the background check and classes that may need to be taken will be paid for by the Department.

FAST SQUAD MEMBERS: Required to meet monthly for training to keep up their certification. We train every fourth Sunday, 5:15 p.m. dinner (optional), meeting at 6:00 p.m.-7:30 p.m.

FIRE DEPARTMENT MEMBERS: Required to meet monthly for training. We meet the first Wednesday of every month at 6:30 p.m.
