

To All Plainfield Voters

**The Primary Election is August 11, 2020.** The primary voting polls are here at the municipal building, 149 Main Street, and will be open from 9am to 7pm on election day.

Voting at the polls will include following safety protocols before entering the polling place: we will check your temperature, you must wear a mask, if you do not have a mask we will provide one for you, and you must sanitize your hands. In order to follow social and physical distancing, only two voters at a time will be able to vote in the polling place at the same time. This will delay voting at the polls, but we must take these precautions for your safety as well as the safety of poll workers and employees.

We have been processing many absentee ballots as a result of the Secretary of State's mailing of absentee request cards. We encourage those voters that have not submitted your card to do so. If you did not receive an absentee request card, just call us at 454-8461 and we will process an absentee request for you. You can also request an absentee ballot online at [mvp.vermont.gov](http://mvp.vermont.gov).

Other Early voting includes the following: **Due to COVID 19 an appointment is required to come into the town clerk's office.**

Vote in the town clerk's office prior to the election.

Voter may take the ballots out of the clerk's office for him or herself and return them to the town clerk's office or by mail.

If you are ill or disabled, you may ask the town clerk on or before the deadline to request an absentee ballot, to have two justices of the peace bring a ballot to you at your home on any day preceding the day of the election or the day of the election.
