

**LOCAL ENFORCEMENT OF SPEED LIMIT ON STATE HIGHWAY**

**The Selectboard of the Town of Plainfield hereby ordains:**

**Article 1. Authority:** This ordinance is adopted by the Town of Plainfield under authority granted by the Town Charter Subchapter 3, 24 VSA Chapter 59, 23 VSA Section 1007, and VSA 13 Section 7251.

**Article 2. Purpose:** The purpose of this ordinance is to promote public safety.

**Article 3. Severability:** If any portion of this ordinance is held unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected.

**Article 4.** The maximum speed limit permitted for any vehicular traffic on Vermont Route 2 within the Town of Plainfield shall be the same as those limits established and posted by the State of Vermont, to wit:

- a. A maximum speed limit of 40 mph beginning 0.47 miles east of TH-16 (mp 0.49) extending easterly to 0.02 miles west of Vermont Route 214 (mp 0.85), and then from this point, 30 mph to the Plainfield/Marshfield Town Line (mp 1.49).
- b. A rough sketch of these speed zones is appended.

**Article 5. Penalties:**

- a. This is a civil ordinance which shall be enforced in accordance with the provisions in 24 VSA section 1974a and 1977 et seq.
- b. The penalty for violation of any of the above speed limits shall be that set by the Schedule of Fines established by the State of Vermont.

**Article 6. Enforcement Officials:** Issuing officials shall include any officer from the Washington County Sheriff's Department or any certified Plainfield Constable.

**Article 7. Effective Date:** This ordinance shall become effective immediately at a duly warned meeting, upon adoption by the Plainfield Selectboard. If a petition is filed under 24 VSA section 1973, the taking effect of this ordinance shall be governed by that statute.

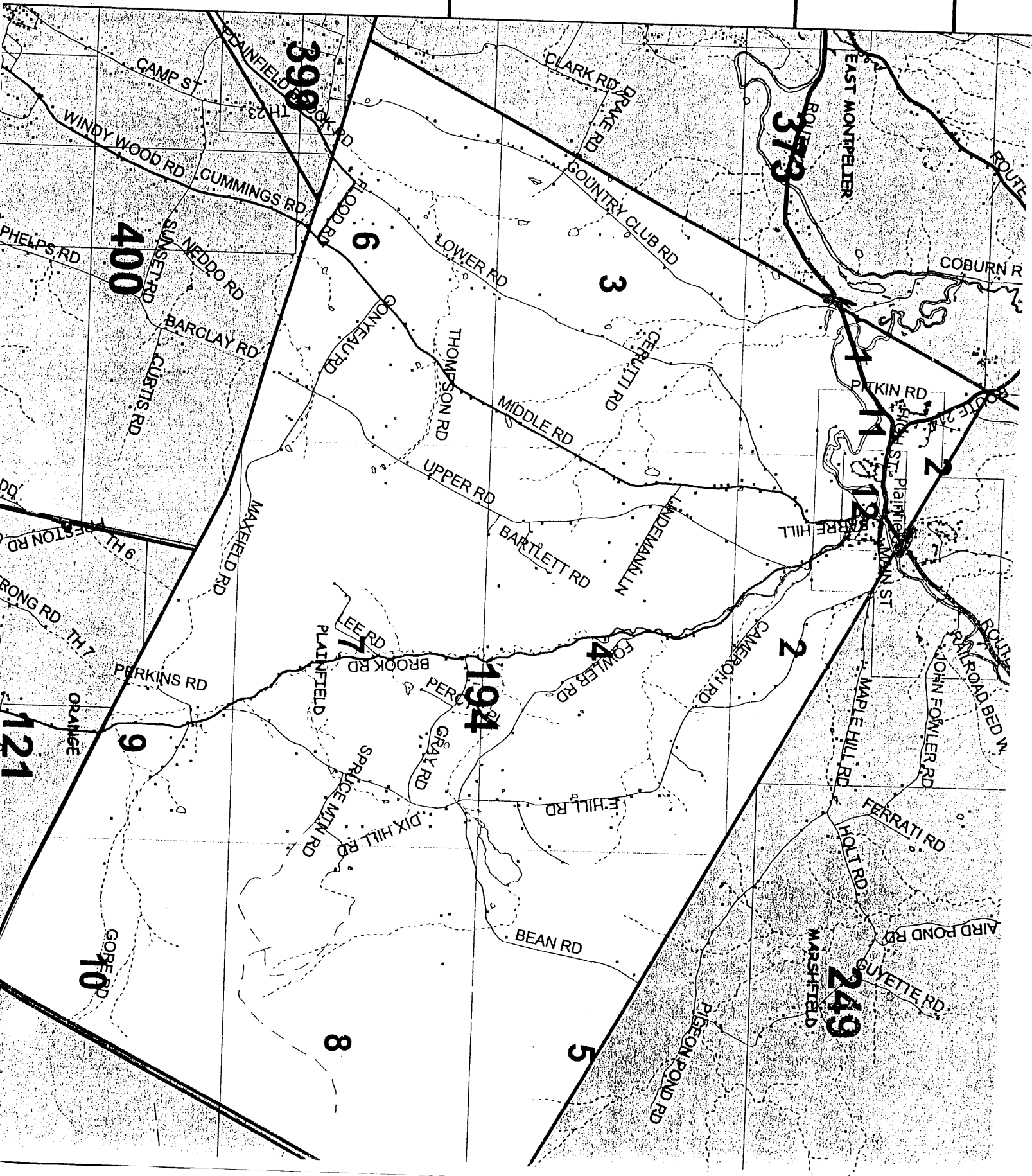
